BLUE VALLEY FARM SHOW 4-H SCHOLARSHIP***

ELIGIBILITY: This scholarship is open to graduating seniors who are past or present members of the Northampton County 4-H Club who plan to attend a technical, trade, or business school or a 2 or 4-year college.

STANDARDS: Selection will be based on community service, school activities, and an essay. AMOUNT: Two \$500 scholarships will be awarded.

TO APPLY: Application forms are available in the Guidance Office. Completed applications must be submitted **by the student** by March 31, 2019, to the address provided in the application. Applicants must also attend an **interview** on May 20, 2019.

EASTON ROTARY CLUB'S YOUNG PERSON OF THE YEAR AWARD***

ELIGIBILITY: This award will be presented to a graduating senior who lives within the bounds of the Easton or Wilson Area School Districts.

STANDARDS: An applicant for this award must meet the following criteria:

- 1. Demonstrates extraordinary service to his/her community, school or family, thereby improving the quality of life for others.
- 2. Exhibits exemplary moral character and citizenship.
- 3. Has distinguished him/herself among peers and elders as a role model for others. The applicant must also submit a an **essay** and an adult **reference.**

AMOUNT: This year's scholarship will be in the amount of \$1,000.

TO APPLY: The application essay and the adult reference are submitted online through Google Forms on the Rotary's web site: https://www.eastonrotary.com/young-person-info.

Transcripts and financial information are not necessary. The completed application must be submitted **by the student** to the Easton Rotary by Wednesday, May 1, 2019.

DR. ALBERT HOFAMMANN SCHOLARSHIP FOR YOUNG PIANISTS***

- ELIGIBILITY: This award is offered to students in Lehigh and Northampton County to be used to continue the study of piano performance.
- STANDARDS: Each applicant must perform two selections from memory. The selections must be from two of the four musical periods: Baroque, Classical, Romantic, or Modern. Total time limit is 15 minutes. The winner of the competition is required to perform his/her selections for the Allentown Music Club on Saturday, April 6, 2019.
- AMOUNT: This award \$1,000 award must be used to continue the study of music performance TO APPLY: The application and information forms, which are available in the Guidance Office, are due by Monday, March 18, and must be **mailed by the student**. The applicant must also call to schedule an audition time. Auditions will be held on Saturday, March 23, 2019, from 5:00 to 7:00 pm.

MARGUERITE ERIKSON IDE SCHOLARSHIP OF THE MOORESTOWN GARDEN CLUB***

- ELIGIBILITY: This scholarship is open to any member of the graduating class who is seeking to further his/her education in the areas of horticulture, landscape architecture, forestry, environmental science, environmental conservation, chemistry, or a related field.
- STANDARDS The candidate must submit a completed application, a copy of the college acceptance letter, and a typewritten essay of 150 words or less explaining why he or she has selected this career path. A high school transcript is not needed.
- AMOUNT: This \$750 scholarship will be awarded directly to the recipient at the May 7, 2019 membership meeting of the Moorestown Garden Club.
- TO APPLY: Application forms are available in the Guidance Office. Completed entries are mailed by the student and must be postmarked by Friday, April 5, 2019.

PAST PRESIDENTS' ASSEMBLY OF THE ALLENTOWN MUSIC CLUB MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP***

- ELIGIBILITY: This award is offered to graduating seniors in Lehigh and Northampton County who have been accepted at an accredited school for the performing arts with a major in **music performance** for the fall following their graduation. Both instrumentalists and vocalists are eligible.
- STANDARDS: The selection of the recipient will be based upon an unedited performance video. Instrumentalists should perform two pieces from two different musical periods, such as: Baroque, Classical, Romantic, or Modern. Singers should perform two pieces in two different languages, and one of them can be English. A brief written description of the student's life goals as a professional musician must also be submitted.
- AMOUNT: This award is in the amount of \$1,000.
- TO APPLY: The application form and information sheet are available on the organization's web site (http://www.allentownmusicclub.com/application-for-scholarship). Application materials must be submitted **by the student** by Sunday, April 4, 2019. The winner is required to perform the audition pieces for the Allentown Music Club on Saturday, May 4, 2019 at 2 PM. Failure to perform will forfeit the prize of \$1,000.
